

### **Eligibility for High School Seniors**

- High School Senior in the Clark County area
- Applicant must be enrolled or will be enrolled in Clark College
- Applicant must attend college on a full-time basis (12 credits or more per term or semester) for the entire academic year
- Applicant must be considered a student in good academic standing with a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average
- Applicant must be in need financial assistance

### **Scholarship Program**

- Seniors can renew the scholarship up to two years with the ability to go further and participate in either Business Management or Cyber Security at Clark College for the 4-year Degree Program.

### **Eligibility for Running Start and Current Clark College Students**

- High School Senior in running start with two years completed or Current Clark student with two years completed
- Applicant must attend college on a full-time (12 credits minimum) basis
- Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average
- Applicant must be in need of financial assistance

### **Scholarship Program**

- Running start or current Clark College students who successfully complete their 2-year associates degree are eligible for up to two additional years if they are enrolled in the Business Management or Cyber Security 4-year degree program at Clark College.

### **How to Apply for the KMR Group/MyBite Foundation Scholarship**

#### **Application Requirements:**

- Complete the online application form in its entirety at [www.kmrgrp.com](http://www.kmrgrp.com)
  - Write a personal statement of up to 500 words (see online application for a list of topics)
  - Write a detailed description of how you plan to finance your education (e.g. financial aid, work, parental assistance). Every applicant must show they have at least attempted to get financial aid by attaching a completed copy of their Free Application for Federal Student Aid
  - Write a paragraph describing your involvement in school or other activities
  - Provide your OFFICIAL high school or college transcript. An official transcript is one issued directly from your high school or college via mail or secure link. The direct secure link should be sent to the scholarship committee at [L.Knight@mybitevitamins.com](mailto:L.Knight@mybitevitamins.com). A scanned copy of your transcript is NOT considered an official transcript.
    - If your high school or college does not send official transcripts electronically, have those documents mailed, to arrive by the deadline, to:

- Official SAT/ACT scores. (are not required for students attending Clark college, but students are strongly encouraged to submit SAT/ACT scores for purposes of scoring scholarship applications.)
- Provide two letters of recommendation from professional references (e.g. instructors, academic counselors, employers, clergy or volunteer supervisors) who can speak to your academic ability, personal qualities, etc.

KMR Group/MyBite Foundation scholarship funds may be used only for tuition, books and fees (does not include late fees). Checks will be made payable to and mailed directly to the recipient's college.

It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure all necessary forms are submitted to MyBite Foundation by the deadline. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

#### **Maintaining the KMR Group/MyBite Foundation Scholarship**

- Once you have been awarded an accepted the scholarship, you are required to attend the following events annually
  - Summer Essential Packs (1<sup>st</sup> year with the scholarship only)
  - Winter Essential Packs
  - Annual Scholarship Luncheon
- Required to attend college full time (12 or more credits)
- Required to maintain at least a 3.0 grade point average
